ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**JOHNSON & WALES UNIVERSITY
AND
CARIBBEAN EXAMINATIONS COUNCIL
CARIBBEAN ADVANCED PROFICIENCY EXAMINATIONS (CAPE)**

Johnson & Wales University will award undergraduate level transfer credit toward a Bachelor of Science Degree for the Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examinations (CAPE) passed with grades of IV or better based on official CXC examination results certificates.

In accordance with the Johnson & Wales University's Transfer Policy:

- CAPE grades of IV or better will be considered for transfer credit.
- Transfer credit can only be granted for subjects which apply to the intended major.
- Accepted applicants to JWU will be provided with an official Transfer Credit Allowance (TCA) upon receipt of final CAPE results certificates showing all examination units passed.
- Applicants who are currently enrolled in CAPE examination subjects may use this course list, in conjunction with the Johnson & Wales University course catalog, to estimate transfer credit for future examinations.
- CAPE examinations will be evaluated course by course, and subjects not included in this agreement will be individually reviewed according to the student's intended major and based on the CXC syllabus to be provided to Johnson & Wales University.

These course equivalencies apply to the JWU catalog year 2009 – 2010 but may be used as a guide for future years, as applicable. Because transfer credit is evaluated on an individual basis, and curriculum changes occur each year, the transfer credit listed here cannot be guaranteed for future academic years or for different degree programs. This articulation agreement may be re-evaluated according to curriculum updates and new information from both institutions.
