#### NOTES TO JANUARY 2026 TIMETABLE

1. The time indicated on the timetable includes Reading Time.
2. Starting times for all centres within a territory are 09:00 hr for the morning session and 13:00 hr for the afternoon session. If at any centre the number of candidates is greater than that which can be accommodated in one session, the Local Registrar may arrange to administer the examination in two or more sessions, ensuring that suitable arrangements are made to preserve the integrity of the examinations.

#### 3. E-Assessment / Hybrid

You are directed to note the changes for e-Assessment for the January 2026 session.

- i. All Paper 1s (Multiple Choice) will be offered online **ONLY**. There will be NO printed question papers.
  - ii. All Paper 2s will be offered as Hybrid **ONLY**. Candidates will be required to read the question paper on screen and enter responses in a Hybrid booklet. There will be NO printed question papers.
  - iii. CSEC Information Technology Paper 032 will be offered online **ONLY**. There will be NO printed question papers. No Hybrid answer booklets are provided for this subject.
  - iv. All other Paper 3/2s except for the Sciences (Biology Paper 3/2, Chemistry Paper 3/2 and Physics Paper 3/2) will be offered as Hybrid **ONLY**. There will be NO printed question papers.
  - v. All candidates will receive a Hybrid answer booklet for the structured papers (Papers 2 and 3/2) in which to write the examination except CSEC IT P3/2 which must be done online **ONLY**.
  - vi. All subjects/components will be automatically selected in the ORS for scheduling on the Surpass platform. Following this, candidates will be issued with keycodes for access to the examinations.

- Candidates taking the Alternative Paper to SBA (Paper 3/2) in the CSEC Single Sciences are permitted to take into the exam room notebooks and/or any materials relevant to the practical examination. When responding to the appropriate question, candidates may refer to their prepared notes.
  - Please note the Supervisor's Reports and Instructions for Setting up Labs should be shared 2 weeks ahead of the examinations for candidates taking the Alternative Paper to SBA (Paper 3/2) in the CSEC Single Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Physics).
  - The Alternative Paper to SBA (Paper 3/2) in all subject offerings must be written by private/non-school candidates **ONLY**.
8. Private/non-school candidates who wish to pursue the January 2026 examination can also register as Resit on condition that they would have submitted SBA scores up to 2 years prior to this sitting.
9. Candidates who register for English A Paper 3/2 and English B Paper 3/2 during the same sitting will be required to write only one examination since both papers will be offered as a common examination.
